Erdinc Civelek was born in Istanbul, Turkey. He received his doctor of medicine degree in 1998 at Hacettepe University Faculty of Medicine and completed residency in the Department of Neurosurgery at Istanbul University Istanbul Faculty of Medicine in 2005. He(as consultant) received the Aysima Altinok Dissertation Award and the Hamit Ziya Gökalp Young Neurosurgeon Award (1st, 2nd and 3rd) from Turkish Neurosurgical Society in 2012.
