



## **Hakan Karabagli**

### **Professor of Neurosurgery at the Selcuk University Faculty of Medicine, Konya, TURKEY**

Dr. Karabagli was born in 1966 in Sivas. He graduated from Dokuz Eylul University Faculty of Medicine in 1990. He completed his neurosurgery residency in Haydarpaşa Numune Training and Research Hospital Neurosurgery Clinic in 1998.

He worked as a “Clinical Fellow” in Marmara University Faculty of Medicine Department of Pediatric Neurosurgery until October 2000.

Dr. Karabagli worked as a "Research Fellow" in the Neurobiology and Anatomy Laboratory of the University of Utah, and as a "Visiting Scholar" in the Pediatric Neurosurgery Clinic of the Primary Children's Hospital of the University of Utah (Turkish Neurosurgical Society's international grant, 2001-2002).

In 2003 he completed the Microsurgery Training course at the Neurosurgery Clinic of the Helsinki University, Faculty of Medicine, Finland. He completed his ESPN courses at 2003.

Dr. Karabagli is focused on endoscopic pituitary surgery, neuroendoscopic arachnoid cyst surgery and endoscopic hydrocephalus treatment. His main practice is adult and pediatric minimally invasive techniques, neuroendoscopic procedures, surgery of congenital disease, neurooncologic surgery, neuroembryology, neurobiology and neuroanatomy.

He was selected for the 2016-2018 period, Turkish Neurosurgical Society executive board member and chairman of pediatric neurosurgery group. He is an associate editor for Turkish Neurosurgery Journal. Dr. Karabagli is member of the editorial board for Child Nervous System. He is member of TND, ISPN (continential liason member), ISPN and AANS.
