He became instructor in neurosurgery in the same clinic in 2012. He was granted Turkish Neurosurgical Society Scientific Research Award and Prof. Nurhan Avman Neurovascular Surgery Scientific Research Award in 2014. He became Associate Professor in Neurosurgery on 4th September 2014. He is currently enrolled in the Advanced Neurosciences PhD Program at the Hacettepe University Institute of Neurological Sciences and Psychiatry. He is a board certified neurosurgeon (Turkish Neurosurgical Society). He has co-authored 44 articles published in the international peer-review journals, one international book, and two chapters in international books. He is a executive committee member of Turkish Neurosurgical Society, Associate Editors of Turkish Neurosurgery and Turkish Neurosurgery Journal (Turkish).
