

Yusuf Izci, holder of a M.D. degree, is a Professor of Neurosurgery and faculty of the University of Health Sciences, Gulhane School of Medicine at Ankara, Turkey. He is also a member of Turkish Neurosurgical Society.

He graduated from Gulhane Military Medical School in 1993 and became a neurosurgeon in 2001 after his residency at Department of Neurosurgery, Gulhane Military Medical Academy.
